## 100 Men Hall

The Hundred Men Hall was established in 1894 by a group of 12 African American residents of Bay St. Louis. This social organizations purpose was to aid the ill, bury the dead and form close social ties with members of the group. the charter stipulated that "the association may from time to time give entertainments for the purpose of replenishing the treasury." This landmark has been recognized for its contribution to the Mississippi Blues trail. Many great blues, rhythm and soul artists have performed at the One Hundred Men Hall for decades.
