COMMUNITY ASSIST

Disability Connection's mission is "Creating a Connected Community to provide social support, ensure healthy futures, eliminate barriers, and foster cooperation and understanding for people with disabilities with priority for seniors, veterans, and children.

Disability Connection (DC) primarily provides assistance through two programs: Community Education and Community Assist. DC also develops special projects such as Accessible Playgrounds and Recreational Tools.

Community Education provides resources such as the MS Gulf Coast Community Resource Guide, The Connection Resource Center, Community Events, MS Gulf Coast Heritage Tours, and the Employment Connection.

Community Assist is a direct service program. Resource Assistants assist callers in connecting with needed services and in some cases DC will provide those services. DC's MS Gulf Coast Community Resource Guide is a community tool that is free to view or download at www.DisabilityConnection.org.

As part of Community Assist Disability Connection assists some individuals in adapting their home for health and safety. Adaption could include a portable ramp or assist bars. If you are a low income senior, 55 and over, veteran, or a person with a physical disability, and own your home, DC may be able to assist you.
