Saturday, Feb 20th is the Arbor Day 5K-1 Mile-1/4 Mile Run/Walk/Roll at Town Green, Biloxi: 1. REGISTRATION AT EVENT: Registration at the event is \$20 (children 12 and under, \$15), paid to the Gulf Coast Running Club. Saturday morning, participants sign-in and get their run bib for the Arbor Day 5K-1 Mile-1/4-mile Run/Walk/Roll. Participants receive a t-shirt. After the race, medallions will be given to individuals with disabilities participating. Those who register on Saturday at the event with the Gulf Coast Running Club may have their t-shirts mailed. 2. REGISTRATION THROUGH DISABILITY CONNECTION TO PARTICIPATE AT TOWN GREEN: Individuals and/or Teams with a physical challenge can pre-register through Disability Connection to participate at the event on Biloxi Town Green for a \$10 per runner fee to offset costs. The fee must be attached to the individual run registration that includes a signature on the Waiver Release. Participants will receive a T-shirt and Medallion at the walk Individual Team Members can run the 5K, 1 Mile, or ¼ Mile. TEAM Captains should turn in their Individual registration forms with their fees and Waiver Signatures before February 12th to guarantee shirts at the event. The race includes a ¼ mile challenge so that everyone, including wheelchairs, can participate in the healthful benefits of a run with awards following. Volunteers do not have to register to assist a runner unless they desire a t-shirt. 3. REGISTRATION FOR A REMOTE WALK: Due to Covid-19 and the need for social distancing for some individuals, DC will accept \$10 pre-registrations before February 12th for any Remote Walk of ¼ Mile or more. After walking, participants will receive the Arbor Day t-shirt and medallion. We are pre-registering
